

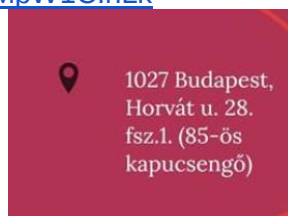
Information on medical assistance from upper year students

General practitioner (who accept the Eu health card)
